2018 Vice-Chancellor's Junior Scholarships

UTS Fencing Club is one of the leading fencing clubs in Australia – it is home to some of the finest Australian National Fencing Representatives; Olympians, National and State Champions.

Professor Attila Brungs, Vice-Chancellor of the University of Technology Sydney, and the Patron of UTS Fencing Club is a long standing supporter of leadership development in junior fencers. To encourage participation of junior fencers in competitions and to recognise their sporting achievement, their contribution to the club, UTS Fencing Club is offering up to 4 scholarships to outstanding junior fencers in 2018.

The benefits of the Junior Scholarship may include:

- A funding grant of up to \$500 towards study costs per year for the duration of the scholarship;
- Subsidies for state and national competition entry fees;
- UTS Fencing training programs
- Junior Scholarship recipients **who go on to enrol into a degree coursework program at UTS** in 2019 will be provided an additional year of grant funding, up to \$500 toward study costs. The terms and conditions of a, b, c, d, e, f, g, and i of the Vice-Chancellor's Junior Scholarship will apply during such period.

Application Criteria:

- A current UTS Fencing Club member.
- Top results in national and/or international cadet, junior and/or senior competitions;
- Demonstrated ability and willingness to be a peer mentor for other UTS Fencing junior members;
- A demonstrated record of participation in UTS Fencing club training, teams and events;
- A good academic record.
- Be currently enrolled in a secondary school.

- List the nominee's sporting achievements and/or awards during the period, 1st June 2017 – 31st May, 2018
- What was the nominee's most outstanding sporting achievement during the period, 1st June 2017 – 31st May, 2018
- Tell us what special about the nominee's sporting success / achievement (maximum 300 words)
- A copy of the nominee's sporting CV
- A copy of a High Resolution photo of the nominee
- A recommendation of School's principle/Year Master – verifying current enrolment, good academic record and other relevant information

Scholarship Terms and Conditions:

The scholarship will be awarded to a current UTS Fencing Club member – who in the club executives' judgement satisfies the application criteria - under the following conditions:

- a) Maintenance of an on-going UTS Fencing membership;
- b) On-going affiliation as a UTS Fencing Club member with the NSW Fencing Association;
- c) Must be available to represent UTS Fencing at National and State Club Teams; National and State individual Championships;
- d) Must be available on an on-going basis at UTS Fencing training sessions and at competitions to provide peer support as required by the club;
- e) Be a brand ambassador for UTS Fencing Club
- f) Adherence to the principles of fair play, inclusion and diversity.
- g) Adherence to an individualised UTS Fencing Club training and competition program as set by the UTS Fencing Club Director of Fencing;
- h) The award duration is for a period of 1 year - 2018 calendar years;
- i) The scholarship holder must notify the Club Executives of UTS Fencing Club, *in writing*, of any change in their circumstances within 10 working days that would affect this award, e.g. change of club affiliation; inability to follow the individualised UTSFC training programs due to injuries. Failure to comply with the Terms and Conditions may result in repayment of the scholarships.
